
- Start by laying the chair on its back. steps to disassemble 1
 - Pull or unscrew the glides (\mathbf{E}) off the leg frame. Use a flat head or phillips head screw driver if needed. 2
 - Separate the bottom cover (\mathbf{B}) from the leg frame (\mathbf{A}) with a phillips head screw driver or allen wrench. 3
 - 4 Locate any screws holding the arms (D) to the leg frame or seat shell, remove the screws and pull off arms.
 - Remove the leg frame from the seat board (\mathbf{C}) with a screw driver and allen wrench. 5
 - Remove the fabric from the seat with a utility knife. 6

- Separate foam from the seat board with putty knife. 7
- For upholstered backs, remove the back shell (G) from the back board (F) using a phillips screw driver to pry them apart. 8
- **9** For mesh backs, separate the (\mathbf{H}) back frame from the (\mathbf{I}) mesh frame with a screw driver.
